Project Description:


The Summer Island Property Owners Association, Inc. is requesting a permit to construct a bulkhead and rip rap revetment at their property on Kiawah Island.

The property is located on an "oxbow" on the north side of Bass Creek adjacent to Summer Island Lane. In this area the increased forces from the currents have caused bank erosion to approach Summer Island Road reducing the critical area and greatly impacting the recreational use of this lot. Unchecked, this evulsion will continue to impact the critical area and affect all the property owners of Summer Island Road.

The proposed erosion control measures are to install a timber bulkhead (approx. 190 lf) and rip rap revetment (approx. 20 lf) to protect the property from tidal water infiltration. This will help reduce critical area impacts.

The property is located on Bass Creek approximately 2.6 miles from the confluence of the Stono River (Lat 32° 37′ 14.12″ N, Long 80° 01′ 52.27″ W) in Kiawah Island, South Carolina (see sheet #1).

Atlantic Surveying, Inc. has contracted with The Summer Island Property Owners Association, Inc. to prepare the permit application for this work and will act as agent through the permitting process. The authorizing signature appears on Page 1 of the joint USACE/DHEC permit application. Exhibit B includes a list of adjacent property owners. Exhibit C contains the legal description of the property and a signed and notarized Affidavit of Ownership or Control concerning the property. Exhibit D is a letter to the USACE from the application stating their understanding that the project is in the jurisdiction of the USACE with SCDHEC-OCRM critical review.
